NOTICE OF REGISTRATION  
FOR PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2024**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that any person not already registered, who possesses the constitutional qualifications of an elector in the City of Melvindale, Wayne County, Michigan, or who will possess such qualifications on the day of the Presidential Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, February 27, 2024, may make application for registration at the City Clerk's Office; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at [mi.gov/vote](http://mi.gov/vote) and mailed to the City Clerk (mail-in registrations must be postmarked on or before February 12, 2024). Voters who are already registered may update their registration at [www.expressSOS.com](http://www.expressSOS.com).

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the City Clerk is **Monday, February 12, 2024**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the City of Melvindale City Clerk's office, located at 3100 Oakwood Blvd., Melvindale, MI 48122 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday thru Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (closed for lunch between 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m.)
- Saturday, February 24<sup>th</sup> from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, February 27<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
