What does an Election Inspector do?

- Controls the flow of voters into the polls, verifies voter identification and dispenses Applications to Vote.
- Search for voters and issue ballots using the Electronic Poll Book
- Supervises distribution of ballots and provides voting instruction
- Supervises the tabulator, collects voter applications and controls flow of voters out of the polls

Hours of work on Election Day are approximately 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. or until all election procedures are completed at the end of the night.

Earn \$200+ when you work Election Day and Early Voting!

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a registered voter in Michigan or 16 years old by Election Day
- Must declare political party affiliation on precinct inspector application
- Must be able to attend training sessions
- Must be able to remain with election chair until all procedures are finished on election night
- Moderate to advanced computer skills are highly desired
